I am directed to state that on consideration of the observations made by the Expert Committee which visited to examine the compliance of the conditions conveyed vide letter No. 2-15/8-III/RC-MB/93 dated May 31, 1994 and the recommendation made by the South-Western Regional Committee, the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), has extended its earlier approval accorded to R N Shetty Polytechnic, Shiyabasaya Nagar, Belgaumfor conduct of following Diploma courses with an annual intake and duration as given below, upto 1995-96.

The Management/Institute/Trust or Society shall not announce admissions directly under any circumstances and shall lawfully abide by the admission Regulations notified by the AICTE vide GSR 476(E) dated 20.05.1994 based on the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated 04.02.1993 with regard to WP (C) No. 607 of 1992 in the case of Unni Krishanan JP and others etc. V/s. State Government of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. and later judgements.

In the event of infringement/contravention or non-compliance of any of the conditions, guidelines, norms, and regulations prescribed by the AICTE from time to time the AICTE or a body or person(s) authorised by it shall be free to take measures for withdrawal of the approval or recognition without consideration of any related issues and that liabilities arising out of such withdrawal would be solely that of the Management/Trust/Society and/or Institutions. AICTE may inspect the institution at any time it may deem fit, to note the progress.

You are requested to kindly take appropriate action to implement the decision of the AICTE and communicate the progress made in this regard to the South-Western Regional Committee of the AICTE under intimation to this office.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

- 1. The Management should purchase land on its own exclusively for the Polytechnic during the academic year 1995-96 and start constructing its own.
- Teaching Faculty strength should be augments by appointing additional staff particularly at the level of Sr. Lecturers having AICTE prescribed qualifications within a period of six months from the issue of approval.
- Teaching faculty strength at the level of Sr. Lecturers/Lecturers should be brought atleast upto 80% of the AICTE norms, during 1995-96.
- HOD's should be appointed for all the Departments.
- AICTE pay scales should be granted to all teaching faculty. Ľ. .
 - 6. The Technical supporting staff strength particularly for workshop, Laboratories, Computer Centre should be augment to conform to AICTE norms.
 - 7. The Administrative staff strength should be augmented to conform to AICTE norms.
 - 8. Library staff strength should be augmented to conform to AICTE norms.
 - o. Library holdings in terms of books & journals should be augmented to meet AICTE norms.
 - 10. Library space should be increased to bring at par with the AICTE norms.
 - 11. The Technical supporting staff strength in Computer Centre should be augmented.
 - 12. Facilities in terms of no. of computers, printers etc. should be augmented to bring at par with AICTE norms. Atleast 10 more computers/terminals should be procured before the commencement of the academic year 1995-96.
 - 13. The built up space of various laboratories should be suitably re-organised/increased to conform to AICTE norms.
 - 14 Laboratories should be strengthened by procuring additional equipment, supporting staff and other facilities as per AICTE norms.
 - Management should create a corpus fund of Rs. 15.0 lacs in a joint account with DTE during 1995-96. 15,
